Notice of Demolition Works

Further demolition works are scheduled over the coming weeks at the Hazelwood Rehabilitation Project.

Demolition of Boiler House Four within the former Hazelwood Power Station site is scheduled to be undertaken, subject to favourable weather conditions, by principal contractor Delta Group on

**Friday, 20 November 2020
between 12 noon and 3pm**

TRAFFIC CONTROL

Brodribb Road and Yinnar Road will be closed on the day near the former Power Station site. Reduced speeds will apply to the Princes Freeway and Strzelecki Highway for approximately three hours before the demolition process and for a further one hour following a successful event.

Due to the size of the Boiler House Four structure, demolition via the discharge of explosive cutting charges so to achieve an engineered controlled collapse, has been assessed as the safest method. The works are being conducted by Delta Group subject to regulatory oversight and in accordance with relevant licences and approvals.

While engineering controls have been implemented to reduce external noise emissions as much as possible, ***local residents are advised they are likely to hear noise at the time of demolition for a few of seconds.***

The Boiler House Four demolition works are an essential component of the ongoing Hazelwood Rehabilitation Project, which is continuing to make meaningful progress in returning the site of the former Hazelwood Power Station and Mine to a productive state for future use.
